Note: It is understood that in the event of an emergency, every effort will be made to contact the parent or person indicated on the CISV Health Form before powers granted to CISV are exercised.

I hereby release CISV and its volunteers from any financial or legal cause of action arising through sickness or accident, except by reason of gross negligence by CISV and/or its volunteers during the CISV programme. In the event of any legal / insurance claim against CISV International Ltd, I / we agree to have the claim settled under the laws of Great Britain.

A CISV participant is expected to conduct her / himself at all times (Both during travel and the CISV programme) in conformance with local laws and CISV rules. Participants engaging in inappropriate behaviour may be sent home before the end of the programme at CISV's discretion and without CISV financial liability (see relevant programme *Guides* for procedure / guidance).

NB: CISV International Ltd accepts NO responsibility for the conduct of participants during travel to / from any of its activities. Furthermore, CISV accepts NO responsibility for actions by or to participants during travel if proper parental authorization forms have not been signed. CISV International Ltd procedures state: "No programme under the supervision of CISV International Ltd involving youth under the age of 16 should be conducted without leaders of legal age accompanying the child during travel and participating in the programme. Youth age 16 - 18 may participate and travel alone provided their parent / guardian signs a legal release relieving CISV of all liability during travel."
